Depth perception can also be improved with contact lenses especially where the right eye and left eye differ – this is because everything is seen 'real size' with contact lenses when your glasses can either magnify or minify what you see depending upon the prescription.

Indoors/outdoors: For outdoor pursuits, contact lenses are available with UV protection which gives another level of protection for your eyes. For indoor sports such as badminton or bowls, troublesome reflections from the lenses in your glasses are eliminated with contact lenses.

Macular Degeneration



Age-related macular degeneration (AMD) is a progressive disease which attacks the very central vision. It usually affects people over 60 but can happen earlier.

AMD is the most common cause of sight loss in the developed world and in the UK there are over 600,000 affected and many are registered visually impaired. There are two types, 'dry' and 'wet'. Unfortunately there is no cure yet although there are some treatments for wet AMD.

AMD destroys the clear detailed, "straight ahead" vision required for reading, driving and other fine tasks we take for granted. It also affects our colour vision.

Dry AMD is a slow gradual change that slowly reduces the clarity of the central vision. Wet is much more sudden and typically results in distortion of vision. This may be noticed by the patient as straight lines such as door frames having a kink in them.

Age is a major risk factor and as we age the cells at the back of the eye don't regenerate as well as when young. Smoking is another major factor and smokers are more than four times more likely to develop it. A good diet and particularly plenty of brightly coloured and dark fruit and vegetables such as kale, spinach, peppers and corn and wearing UV protection are also important.

When we test your eyes we use several techniques to check for AMD. The Optometrist will look directly into the eye to view the macula and can also take a digital photo to give an accurate picture. Use of a grid chart may be needed to check for subtle changes. During the appointment our Optometrist will talk to you and offer advice on ways to reduce your risk and help delay any changes, particularly if you have a family history of macular degeneration. Research into treatments is ongoing and in years to come retinal cell transplants or stem cell therapy, or even implantation of digital devices may offer restoration of vision.
